During this journey, most of our children also got fully vaccinated. We would also request the remaining parents to get their children vaccinated as and when the government opens the slot.


The school will continue to work on innovative and creative ideas for the betterment of our children. We look forward for the continued support from parents and teachers to achieve more n more.
